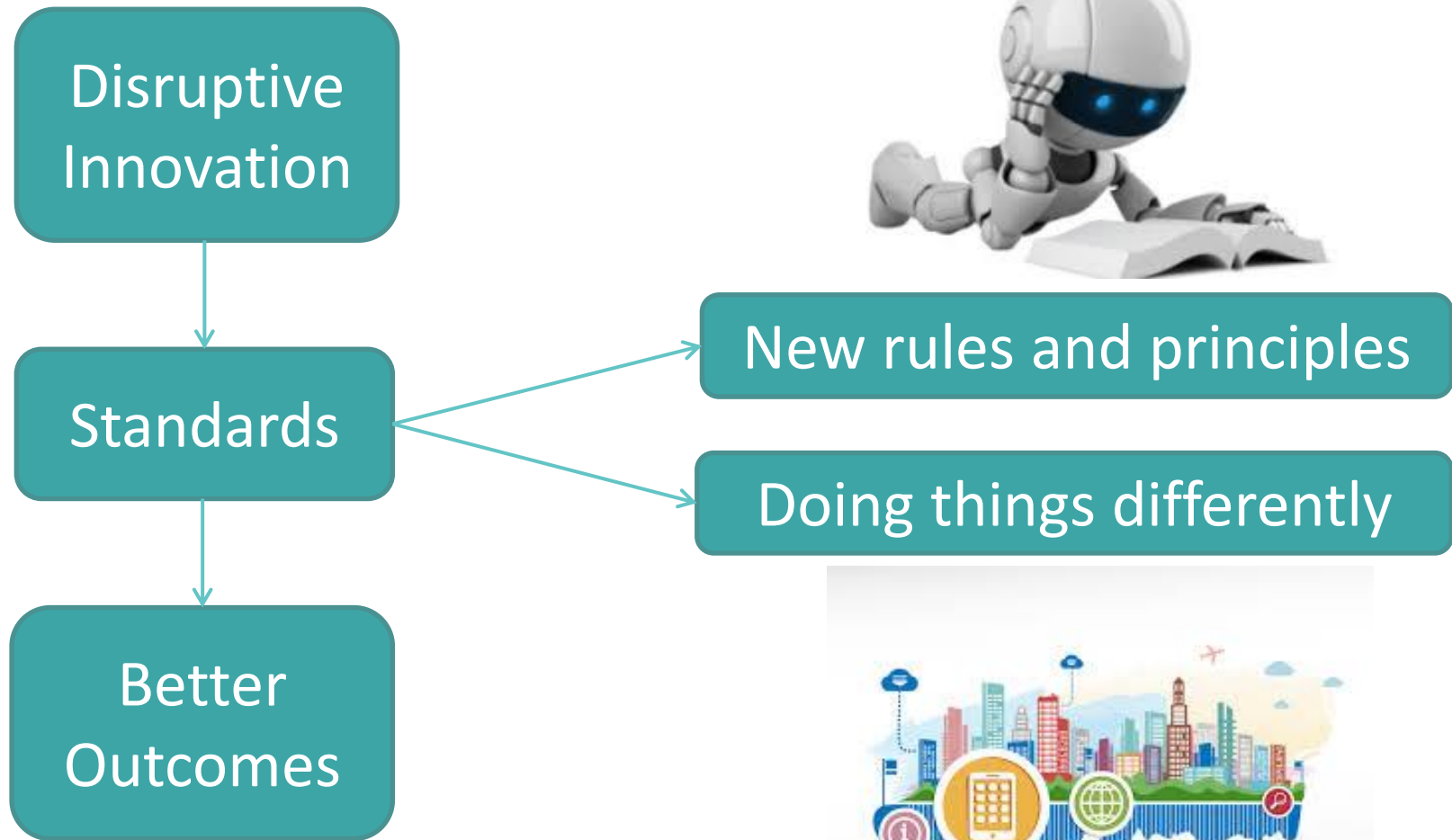

- IWA 18:2016 (15 countries, WHO, OECD)
- ISO SAG, three recommendations
 - New ISO TC
 - Ad-hoc strategy and communications groups
 - Priority areas
- New ISO committee
 - Ballot closes 26 October 2017
 - First meeting expected April 2018
